

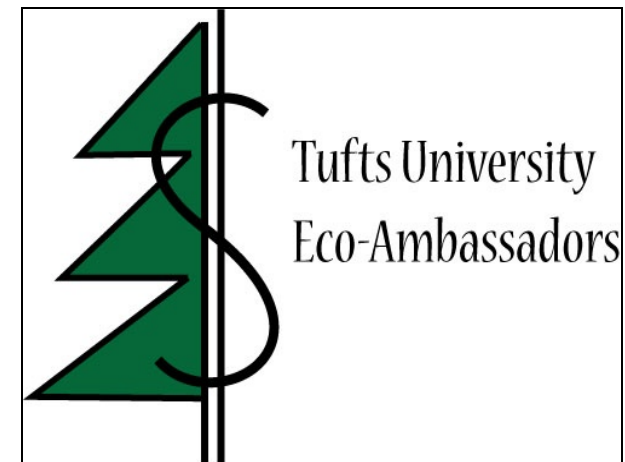
About the Tufts Office of Sustainability

Become an Eco-Ambassador



The Office of Sustainability at Tufts wants to help staff members - the stewards of the university's departments and offices - make their workplaces more sustainable and to serve as sustainability resources within their offices or departments.



Program Description

The 2009-2010 Eco-Ambassador Program will be spread out over the entire year and will be open to all interested staff. To be recognized as an official Eco Ambassador and be eligible for grants to help launch office greening projects, individuals must attend at least 8 sessions. The sessions will all take place over an extended lunch period (12-2 PM), usually during the first week of the month.
