Dear Tufts Environmental,

The Office of Sustainability was featured in today's Tufts Daily for the silver rating the university received from the Sustainability Tracking, Assessment and Rating System (STARS). The rating system is run by the Association for the Advancement of Sustainability in Higher Education (AASHE) and gives colleges and universities sustainability ratings based on self-reported data. Tufts earned a silver rating with 62.73 points, just shy of the 65 needed for a gold. Rachael Wolber, an intern here at the Office of Sustainability, was largely responsible for compiling and submitting the data for the 2011 STARS report. This reporting system allows schools to see what kind of programs other schools have implemented with regards to sustainability, and allows them to look at ways to improve. Tufts' STARS report was submitted under version 1.0, which uses 2005 as a base year for comparison in many categories. This puts Tufts at slight disadvantage, considering, for example, we have been recycling since 1990 while many schools have only recently begun to do so. While there is still definite room for improvement in on-campus sustainability and we hope to address some of the issues with version 1.0 in the next version of the rating system, for now Tufts can be very proud of its efforts to become a truly sustainable institution. Congratulations everyone!
