Setting Baselines Far from Shorelines in the Largest and Deepest World Heritage Site: The Phoenix Islands Protected Area

The Phoenix Islands Protected Area (PIPA), located within the Republic of Kiribati, is the second largest marine protected area (MPA) in the world. Roughly the size of California, this reserve hosts 8 islands, 7 of which are



uninhabited. One of the islands, Nikamoruro, is thought to be the final landing place of Amelia Earhart. Kanton was used as a strategic military outpost during WWII and also hosts remnants of Pan Am's aviation outfit as part of their "hop across the Pacific." PIPA hosts 439 species of fish, 200+ coral species, and large populations of manta rays, turtles, sharks, bumphead parrotfish, napoleon wrasse, giant clams, and other spectacular marine life. In
