## **Position Description:**

The Office of Sustainability seeks a Zero Waste Events & Outreach Intern to assist the Recycling and Waste Reduction Coordinator in organizing sustainable waste management at university events throughout the school year. The Office of Sustainability works to ensure events are educational and effective. The chosen candidate will educate event planners, caterers, and guests on minimizing waste at Zero Waste Events. Job duties include organizing supplies for events, ensuring that all necessary zero-waste infrastructure is in place for each event, and, as necessary, work at zero waste stations during events.

This position is perfect for someone interested in recycling and waste diversion, education, outreach, team-building, collaboration, and event management. This intern will hone efficient customer relations, peer leadership, logistics experience, planning, outreach, and presentation skills.

#### **Hours & Timeframe:**

This is an academic year position and starts during the first week of September 2021 with a commitment of 8-10 hours a week. Must be flexible and able to work outside of the regular 9 AM - 5 PM business hours.

All work will be done in accordance with Tufts' COVID-19 safety protocol, including masks and social distancing. The nature of the position requires in-person work with an occasional opportunity for remote work.
