The Project:

- Students opt-in to the program and pay a \$4 deposit for a keychain clip.
- The student will turn in their clip for a to-go box with their meal.
- When finished, they can turn the box back in for their clip.
- If a keychain clip or box is lost, the student must repay the fee. Damaged items will be replaced using these fees.
- Containers will be returned for cleaning and reuse, as they are food safe and eventually recyclable.
