

Become an On-Call Waste Worker

The Office of Sustainability relies on on-call student workers to make our events and initiatives a success. When help is needed throughout the year, we reach out to students on the on-call list.

Students will be paid **\$12 an hour**. Any student can fill the following positions:

- 1. Recycling Worker:** These workers help manage waste during student move-in and move-out. They monitor dumpsters, circulate residence halls to educate students and parents about how to sort and dispose of their waste, and help break down cardboard boxes and collect plastic film.
- 2. Zero-Waste Event Station Monitor:** These workers monitor the waste stations at large campus events with food to make sure all waste is sorted properly. They monitor the compost bins and make sure recyclables and trash end up in the proper bags. A free meal is included!
- 3. Zero-Waste Event Team Lead:** These workers coordinate the rest of the workers at a zero-waste event. They pick up and distribute supplies, strategically place waste stations, make sure the place settings at the event are compostable, and assign workers to waste stations.
- 4. General On-Call Worker:** These workers are willing to help with Office of Sustainability tasks outside of the positions listed above. This could include putting signs up around campus or managing move-out donations.
